All swimmers under the age of 18 must be under the supervision of a Club Coach or designated Club Official at all times whilst in the vicinity of the lake.

THE SWIMMERS PLACED FIRST, SECOND & THIRD IN AN ASA/SASA/WASA REGIONAL OPEN WATER CHAMPIONSHIPS, BEING A MEMBER OF A CLUB IN THAT REGION, WHO DOES NOT ACHIEVE THE ENTRY BY MEANS OF A POOL BASED SWIM, MAY ALSO ENTER THE NATIONAL OPEN WATER CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR THAT AGE GROUP (Age Groups & Distances see conditions below)

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### AGE GROUP CONDITIONS

#### **Event Conditions:**

- 1. A swimmer shall have joined the club in whose name he is entered at least 60 days prior to the date of the competition.
- 2. Foreign competitors will be accepted if they are from one of the countries affiliated to FINA
- 3. Age Groups and Distances are: Girls and Boys 12-14 1.5km; 15/16yrs 3km 17 & over 5km
- 4. Ages as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016
- 5. Entry Fee: £12
- 6. Medals will be awarded to the first 3 male and female swimmers in each of the following age groups: 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17/18, 19 +
- 7. A cut off time limit of 30 minutes after the swimmer in each competition has finished shall operate.
- 8. Registration: Swimmers MUST sign in at the registration desk at the appropriate time.
- 9. Any swimmer representative (coach/chaperone) not attending the briefing will result in the swimmer NOT being allowed to swim
- 10. Competitor No: Competitors must have their number displayed on their back or upper arms and wear the numbered hat provided. (if wearing two caps the numbered cap to be on top).
- 11. Swim Gear: No swimmer shall be permitted to use or wear any device, which may be an aid to their speed, endurance or buoyancy. Goggles, cap nose clip and may be worn Only one costume is allowed. Costumes must comply with FINA Open Water rules.
- 12. Grease: Swimmers shall be allowed to use grease or other substances providing these are not deem as excessive, in the opinion of the referee.
- 13 Protests shall be made and dealt with as detailed in ASA Law; the Promoter shall be the Midland Championship Steering Group.
- 14. Any matters not provided for in these conditions shall be decided by the Midland Championship Steering Group.

### **Masters Event Conditions**

- 1. Masters swimmers may wear wet suits but will not be considered for medals.
- 2.. A time limit of 30 minutes shall apply from the finish time of the 1<sup>st</sup> swimmer in each event
- Masters events shall be 3km and 1.5km in the following ages:
   Masters Age Groups 19 24 25 29 30 34 35 39 40 49 50 59 60+
- 4. Masters may choose which of the two distance they wish to swim in. Age as of 31st December 2016
- 5. Entrée Fee £12.00.
- 6. Medals will be awarded to the first three male and female swimmers in each of the following age group 19-24, 25-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60+
- 7. A cut off time limit of 30 minutes after the swimmer in each competition has finished shall operate.
- 8. Registration: Swimmers MUST sign in at the registration desk at the appropriate time.
- 9. Any swimmer representative (coach/chaperone) not attending the briefing will result in the swimmer NOT being allowed to swim
- 10. Competitor No: Competitors must have their number displayed on their back or upper arms and wear the numbered hat provided. (if wearing two caps the numbered cap to be on top).
- 11. Swim Gear: No swimmer shall be permitted to use or wear any device, which may be an aid to their speed, endurance or buoyancy. Goggles, cap nose clip and may be worn Only one costume is allowed. Costumes must comply with FINA Open Water rules.
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
